## **Clinical Experience**

#### Assessment

- Providing highly specialist mental health assessments and formulation of children, young people and their families.

- Assessment of the impact of child maltreatment and developmental trauma, including emotional, physical and sexual abuse and neglect.
- Cognitive assessment of children, adolescents and adults.
- Diagnostic assessment of neurodevelopmental difficulties, such as Autism and ADHD.

#### Intervention

- NICE guideline recommended interventions for a range of mental health difficulties, including PTSD, OCD, anxiety and depression in children and adolescents
- Integrative therapeutic interventions with children and adolescents using mentalisation, systemic, narrative and cognitive-behavioural therapies.
- Individual, group and family interventions for children and parents, including parenting interventions.
- Systemic interventions for attachment difficulties, developmental trauma, and parent-child relationships.
- Psychological intervention for parents presenting with complex trauma, anxiety and depression.
